## Stand Up and Be Recognized!

The 2018 awards season begins now and culminates with an awards presentation in fall 2018 with each recipient receiving \$7,000 for his/her school, as well as a \$1,000 personal award.

The awards process will help the selection committee identify the best among the best and ensure that the excellence of New Jersey's educational leaders is properly celebrated.

## Awards Process

How does the awards process work?

- The nominee must submit: a resumé; two letters of recommendation (one from a superintendent/principal and a second from a teacher, parent, or student); and a brief essay describing one of the nominee's transformational achievements that improved the quality of education in his/her school.
- Applications will be reviewed by the NJPSA Awards Committee. Using a rubric, the awards committee will select finalists in each category.
- Once selected, the awards committee chair will contact the finalists to schedule a site visit at their schools.
- When appropriate, individuals selected as the Visionary Principal of the Year and the Visionary Vice/Assistant Principal of the Year will become the New Jersey nominees for the corresponding NAESP and NASSP National Awards.
- NJPSA Visionary Leadership Award Winners will be announced in spring 2018 and recognized at the 2018 NJPSA/FEA/NJASCD Fall Conference.



## Eligibility Requirements

- All nominees **must** serve in the position for which they are being recognized during the 2018-2019 school year.
- All nominees must have completed **five years** in their current position.
- **Only Premier Active NJPSA members may be nominated.**

## Award Application Deadline
